Directions to the Hagerstown Cracker Barrel restaurant:

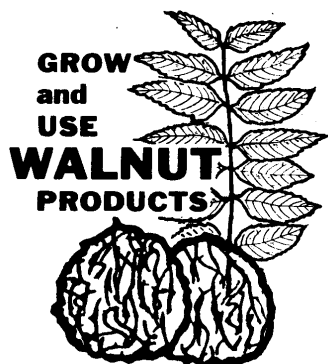
From the East (Baltimore/Frederick):

- Take Interstate 70 West to Exit 29, for Route 65 (Sharpsburg Pike). Turn **left** at the light at the bottom of the ramp to go South on Rt. 65 (toward Sharpsburg). Go approximately 0.3 miles, passing through one traffic light. Turn **right** at the second traffic light, onto Col. Henry K. Douglas Drive. Go approximately 250 feet and turn **left** into the Cracker Barrel parking lot.

From the West (Hancock/Cumberland):

- Take Interstate 70 East to Exit 29-A, for Route 65 South (Sharpsburg Pike). At the bottom of the ramp, continue in the lane you are in for approximately 0.1 miles, and turn **right** onto Col. Henry K. Douglas Drive. Go approximately 250 feet and turn **left** into the Cracker Barrel parking lot.
